(these notes do NOT form part of the Sailing Instructions)

### Schedule of Starting Signals (using RRS 26)

Sequence	Timing	Flag signal	Notes
1	approx. 10 mins before Start	↑ Orange 	attention signal
2	5 mins before Start	↑ F 	Warning signal
3	4 mins before Start	↑ P 	Preparatory signal
4	1 min before Start	↓ P 	1-minute signal
5	<b>START</b>	↓ F 	Starting signal
(6a)	OCS – ‘On Course Side’	↑ X 	IF Boat/s are over - 'OCS' - at the Start!
(7a)	When <u>all</u> OCS boat/s have returned to correct side of line OR 4 mins after start time.	↓ X 	(no sound signal)
(6b)	General Recall - TWO sound signals	↑ 1 <sup>st</sup> Sub 	IF all boats are to return for a new start sequence
(7b)	1 min before the Warning Signal for the re-start	↓ 1 <sup>st</sup> Sub 	(one sound signal)
Signals 1- 6a are accompanied by <u>one</u> Sound Signal			

**IF** a boat is not clear of the Starting Line at the signal, you will hear TWO sound signals – one for the Start (Flag F down), & one for any OCS boat/s (Flag X up).

Flag X is then displayed until **all** OCS boats have returned clear to the pre-start side of the Start Line (so if you are the only OCS boat, watch the X Flag – when Flag X comes down, you have returned clear to the pre-start side of the line!).

If one or more OCS boats do **not** return clear, Flag X is left displayed for 4 minutes.

**IF** a General Recall is signalled, you will heard THREE sound signals – one for the Start then two more for the Recall : One sound signal is made later when the 1<sup>st</sup> Sub flag is removed.

The Finish : look for a BLUE flag  OR, if course is being shortened, Flag S
